#### Summary:

The Cushing Industrial Authority (CIA) acquired adjoining vacant lots situated at 114 S. Steele Street and 318 E. Cherry (northwest corner of Cherry and Steele Streets). David and Kerri Harris donated the property to the CIA in 2022. The previous structure on the property was razed by the City and the lots were cleared. The CIA does not have a designated purpose for the lots, and these are additional lots that we must maintain.

Staff is recommending the properties be declared surplus as one, listed for sale by sealed bid subject to the right of those submitting a sealed bid to raise their bid at the time of the bid opening to obtain the highest bid on the properties, and the City Manager be authorized to sell such properties, or authorize the City Manager to donate the properties as part of a Trustee approved economic development project. Staff does not intend to have the properties appraised unless directed to do so by the Commission prior to listing the properties and soliciting sealed bids. The Payne County Assessor has assessed the combined property value at \$7,160.00.





#### I. Summary

Grant applications are now being accepted for the Recreational Trails Program through the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department. Application deadline is March 31, 2024. This is the same grant program that funded the Memorial Park Wellness Trail improvements.

We have been in discussions with CLS & Associates about the grant program. CLS is the firm that completed the most recent trail head in Memorial Park and helped us develop our Recreational Master Plan for the City of Cushing. CLS recently helped Cushing Public Schools obtain their recent TSET grant.

They have submitted a proposal for landscape architectural services in the amount of \$6,400.00 to prepare and submit the grant application to make additional improvements to the Tiger Trail, a Cushing Public School's project, which will encompass a portion of the Cushing Sports Complex.

#### II. Fiscal Impact

The Recreational Trails Program is a reimbursable grant, meaning the project sponsor must pay all project costs as they are incurred. Sponsors then may request reimbursement for 80 percent of eligible expenses. The maximum grant amount is \$300,000.00. TSET funds recently awarded to Cushing Public School's will count as part of our leverage so we will not be required to allocate any matching funds. We will apply for the maximum allowable grant amount.

Staff is recommending that funding for this project be allocated from the Cushing Hospital Authority since the proposed trail additions fit its purpose. One of the purposes of the CHA listed in its indenture is to "construct...maintain [and]...equip... related [training] facilities." The indenture also calls for the trust authority to be able to construct and maintain facilities operated by the municipality. The walking trail project fits within the purposes and goals of the CHA trust indenture and expenditure of CHA funds on such a project both makes sense and is allowable.

A budget amendment is necessary to cover the cost of the proposal from CLS and has been prepared by Finance Director Jerrica Worthy in a separate action. Staff is recommending funds be allocated from 370-500-5627, which does not create a negative budget impact.

#### **III. Recommended Action**

Authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement between the Cushing Hospital Authority and CLS & Associates for services outlined in their proposal to prepare the Recreational Trails Program grant.

- Materials required for trail work
- Equipment purchase or rental for development and maintenance of trails
- Direct labor costs or service contracts
- Directional, regulatory and interpretive signage
- Trail grading, surfacing and drainage
- Crossing structures, bridges, railings and ramps
- Bank stabilization and retaining structures
- Trail corridor revegetation and erosion control
- Functional trail lighting
- Trailhead development (parking, restrooms and related facilities)
- Trailside amenities (benches, lighting, fencing, exercise equipment)
- Trail maintenance and rehabilitation
- Acquisition of land or permanent easements essential to trail access
- Essential, site-specific engineering or professional design
- Required natural and cultural resource permits, surveys or clearances
