### I. Summary:

The Cushing Police Department proposes purchasing ten (10) sets of replacement body armor. Per departmental policy, body armor shall be replaced prior to the manufacturer's expiration date or when the armor becomes worn/damaged. We currently have ten (10) sets of body armor that have reached the manufacturer expiration. To ensure the safety of our officers and comply with policy, this body armor needs to be replaced.

Although funding was allocated for the project in the FY 23 – 24 budget, staff secured partial reimbursement funding from the Bureau of Justice, Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership grant program. The program requires each applicant to be responsible for providing upfront funding with 50% reimbursement for qualifying body armor purchases.

We received a State Contract quote (SW0764) from Special Ops Uniforms, Inc., an Oklahoma City based company. Special Ops Uniforms has been a long-time vendor for police uniforms and body armor. Their quote for the purchase of ten (10) sets of body armor and carriers was \$14,070.00. The cost breakdown is as follows:

After the purchase of our Lifepak cardiac monitors in each ambulance, a built-in warranty and maintenance coverage plan was included in the purchase. The current contract has expired and is ready for renewal. Oklahoma State Department of Health requires a yearly inspection of these monitors by a professional service technician to assure the user that all calibrations are accurate and all functions in working order. The final report of the inspection for each unit must be kept on file and presented to the state health department, when requested, during facility inspections. Included in the Stryker ProCare preventative maintenance plan is maintenance inspection service, documentation for regulatory bodies, labor and travel expense included and replacement of batteries at no additional costs. Labor costs are quoted at \$320 per hour with a one hour minimum per unit, battery costs are approximately \$350 per battery with a total of 16 batteries for all four units. The service contract covers one year of maintenance with a total cost of \$5,844.60.

**Subject:** Shade Covering at Sports Complex

# I. Summary:

Staff is recommending the purchase shade covers at the Cushing Sports Complex, providing shade and a measure of protection from errant balls. Shade coverings will be installed around the spectator seating area for baseball and softball. In addition, this will be an aesthetic improvement for the complex.
