

CUSHING YOUTH & COMMUNITY CENTER CODE OF CONDUCT

Cushing Youth & Community Center (CYCC) has implemented the following Code of Conduct to be followed by parents, spectators and youth participants in CYCC activities.

Persons who violate this Code of Conduct will be subject to discipline including verbal warnings, expulsion from the event activity, suspension from game(s), forfeiture of game and/or forfeiture of the privilege of attending future games or activities. Violations may be imposed by coaches, game officials or CYCC representatives.

As a Player, I agree:

I will respect my coach, players on my team, players on the teams we play and game officials. I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct (abusive language, refusal to shake hands, gesturing, taunting, etc.)

As a Parent, I agree to:

1. Accept all decisions made by the game officials.
2. Demonstrate good sportsmanship at CYCC activities.
3. Refrain from actions that may endanger the safety or comfort of the players, coaches, game officials or spectators.
4. Be a positive role model and watch the game and competition in the spirit in which it was intended: as a RECREATION sponsored activity of CYCC for the physical and social development of the players.
5. The photographing and filming of myself or child involved in Cycc Sports or at a Cycc event and that it can be used for Sporting highlights, advertising, commercials or other business purposes.
6. Not to engage in any behavior with the intent to initiate, hurt, intimidate or humiliate any player, coach, official or spectator. Negative, demeaning or derogatory comments, including those posted on social media, will not be tolerated. These acts shall be considered harassment and may result in disciplinary action, including removal from the team, if necessary. Understand that social media is just a microphone and you will be responsible for your actions.
